WINNIPEG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TO LEAD DELEGATION TO OTTAWA

June 2, 2006 – The Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce will lead a delegation of business leaders to Ottawa on June 5th and 6th to lobby the Federal government on a number of key issues.

Winnipeg Chamber of Commerce President and CEO Dave Angus said meetings have been scheduled with a number of Ministers focusing on issues important to the future of the City of Winnipeg such as:

- The Canadian Museum for Human Rights
- Increased Infrastructure Funding
- Fiscal Imbalance for Cities
- Expansion of the Public Health Agency in Winnipeg

“A number of key stakeholders will be part of the delegation, including the University of Manitoba, Destination Winnipeg and the Manitoba Heavy Construction Association, to help impress upon the Federal government the importance of these issues to The Chamber,” said Angus.

“The Chamber believes it’s important that the concerns of the Winnipeg business community are heard in Ottawa,” concluded Angus. “We will ensure that continues to happen.”
