

Premier Pallister to give details of Manitoba's economic action plan

2017 State of the Province provides opportunity to share Deloitte report highlights

December 4, 2017, Winnipeg – Winnipeg's business community eagerly anticipates hearing details of the provincial government's economic growth strategy at the upcoming State of the Province Address.

"We commissioned Deloitte to do a cross-jurisdictional analysis of what economic strategies are working in other jurisdictions, not just in Canada but around the world," noted Premier Brian Pallister in a recent video interview with The Chamber, referencing the Framework for Economic Alignment and Growth Strategy. "I'll be sharing some details of that with our guests at the event."

Last year's State of the Province broke attendance records when more than 1,300 community, industry and labour leaders gathered to hear the Premier's first address since taking office. Loren Remillard, President & CEO of The Winnipeg Chamber anticipates similar interest this year.

"From carbon pricing to cannabis legalization, health care restructuring to tax reform, there is an incredible number of pressing issues we look forward to hearing about from the Premier," says Remillard. "Add on top of that the first reveal of the Province's economic development plan and we're expecting a full, engaged audience."
